



# COOKIES

## 1. What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file which is stored on your equipment, and often including a unique identifying. Through web server, cookie is sent by the internet website to the equipment used by the user (computer, tablet, phone, and so on) and is stored on the hardware.

The website [www.join.lu](http://www.join.lu) store the information on the preferences of the users (language used on the website, purchases in the shopping cart, and so on) in order to live a better client experience.


## 2. Right of objection at the storing of the cookies

The user may exercise his right of objection at the storing of the cookies in configuring his web server as following:

In Microsoft Internet Explorer:

1. Select the "Tools" button, and then select "Internet options"
2. Select the "Privacy" tab
3. Under Settings, move the slider to the top to block all cookies (or the bottom to allow all cookies), and the select "OK"

In Mozilla Firefox:

1. Click the menu button  and choose "Options"
2. Select the "Privacy" panel and go to the "History" section
3. In the drop-down menu next to "Firefox will": choose "Use custom settings for history"
4. Check mark "Accept cookies from sites" to enable cookies, and uncheck it to disable them

In Chrome:

1. At the top right, click "More" > "Settings"
2. At the bottom, click "Advanced"
3. Under "Privacy and Security", click "Content settings"
4. Click "Cookies"
5. Check or uncheck "Cookies"

In Safari:

1. Choose "Safari > "Preferences"
2. Click "Privacy"
3. Select a "Cookies and website data" option
